

Denver Firefighters Museum

Photograph Collections

The photograph collection of the Denver Firefighters Museum is available to researchers. Copies of the photographs are available, unless restricted, for a fee based on the size of the photograph, digitized photograph or print, and the intended use of the photograph.

Conditions

The purchase of photographs constitutes an agreement to comply with the following conditions:

1. Reproduction of photographs requires the written permission of the Denver Firefighters Museum. Fees are explained below:
Permission for reproduction is granted for one-time use only.
Subsequent use requires written permission and the payment of additional fees.
2. All reproduced photographs must be credited as follows: “The Denver Firefighters Museum, Denver, Colorado.” Proper credit must be given to the photographer when known.
 - a. With printed material it is preferred that the credit line appear on the same or facing page of the photograph or with “Sources of Photographs.” Each individual item must be credited.
 - b. With exhibitions, credit must be shown below the photograph of as part of the label copy in the exhibit area.
3. Photographs of any of the objects or documents in the collection of the Denver Firefighters Museum whose intended use is any form of publication must be obtained from the Museum along with written permission from the Museum to use said photographs.

4. Commercial use of photographs is subject to additional fees and requires the written permission of the Denver Firefighters Museum.
5. Responsibility for questions of copyright that may arise are assumed by the user.
6. The Denver Firefighters Museum reserves the right to limit the number of photographic copies; to restrict the use or reproduction of rare or valuable material; to ensure the reproductions are in good taste; to make special quotations on material involving unusual difficulty in copying; and to charge a copying fee higher than specified for a small number of special items. Prior to publication, the Denver Firefighters Museum reserves the right to require a proof for approval.
7. A complimentary copy of any published work using a Museum photograph will be provided to the Denver Firefighters Museum.

Processing Fees:

When a photograph is ordered, the total due is the sum of the processing fee, applicable service fee, postage fee, and photocopy fee (if any). If the item to be used as a non-commercial, non-profit reproduction by an individual not connected with a business, or used for personal research or display in a private home, only processing fees apply.

Processing time for orders is approximately two to three weeks whether it be a digitized print or a print from an original negative. Photocopies of photographs can be provided at a cost of .50 cents a copy.

Digitized Prints:

4x6, 5x7, or 8x10 \$10.00 per print

Photographic Prints:

4x6 \$10.00 per print

5x7 \$10.00 per print

8x10 \$10.00 per print

Other \$ dependent on size

Negatives:

When a copy negative needs to be created in order to provide a requested print, the patron will be charged a negative fee for this service. All negatives remain the property of the Denver Firefighters Museum.

Commercial Reproduction Fees:

In addition to processing fees, reproduction fees are charged for the commercial use of photographs.

A. Fee per photograph for books and similar printed items:

1. 1 to 5,000 copies.....\$10.00

2. 5,000 to 10,000 copies.....\$30.00

3. 10,001 to 25,000 copies.....\$100.00

4. Over 25,000 copies.....\$150.00

B. Fee per photograph for publication in a serial or newspaper:

1. Under 50,000 circulation.....\$10.00

- 2. 50,000-100,000.....\$50.00
- 3. Over 100,000.....\$100.00

C. Fee per photograph for video tapes and disks for resale:

- 1. 1,000 and under.....\$10.00
- 2. 1,001-5,000.....\$30.00
- 3. 5,000 and over.....\$50.00

D. Special uses, per image:

- 1. Commercial Display.....\$25.00
- 2. Book jacket (add to “A” above).....\$50.00
- 3. Commercial motion picture/TV broadcasts, one time use.....\$75.00
- 4. Commercial motion picture/TV broadcasts-unlimited
worldwide broadcast and cable; unlimited videos for
resale; rights to use in one production in perpetuity..... \$250.00
- 5. Advertising\$100.00
- 6. Posters, postcards and similar mass-produced items
1,000 and under.....\$25.00
- 7. Website: special conditions apply
